- 2 major objectives: transform the city to adapt it to climate change & preserve the real estate, furniture and plant heritage.

- Street furniture and new uses.
- Buildings and landscape (linked to the schedule for the revision of the local urban plan, accessible by 2024).

• 3 categories of data:

- Sum of scientific contributions for which many academics and professionals will be solicited.
- Action reference for the Parisian administration on architecture, urban design and street furniture.
- Normative integration in the local bioclimatic urban plan (PLU).




Contribution to Paris Town Planning Agency (APUR): Atlas of Parisian street furniture


 Reveal how much furniture has multiplied, diversified and specialized throughout history.


- 9 families of furniture described:






